SERMON TEXT Genesis 25:1-11

¹ Abraham took another wife, whose name was Keturah. ² She bore him Zimran, Jokshan, Medan, Midian, Ishbak, and Shuah. ³ Jokshan fathered Sheba and Dedan. The sons of Dedan were Asshurim, Letushim, and Leummim. ⁴ The sons of Midian were Ephah, Epher, Hanoch, Abida, and Eldaah. All these were the children of Keturah. ⁵ Abraham gave all he had to Isaac. ⁶ But to the sons of his concubines Abraham gave gifts, and while he was still living he sent them away from his son Isaac, eastward to the east country.

⁷ These are the days of the years of Abraham's life, 175 years. ⁸ Abraham breathed his last and died in a good old age, an old man and full of years, and was gathered to his people. ⁹ Isaac and Ishmael his sons buried him in the cave of Machpelah, in the field of Ephron the son of Zohar the Hittite, east of Mamre, ¹⁰ the field that Abraham purchased from the Hittites. There Abraham was buried, with Sarah his wife. ¹¹ After the death of Abraham, God blessed Isaac his son. And Isaac settled at Beer-lahai-roi.

The Jews Fundamentally Misunderstood what it Meant to Be Children of Abraham and the Covenant Sign

- 1. Abraham was justified by his trust in God, not his good works (Romans 4:1-8)*
- 2. Circumcision of the heart, not the foreskin, was the true sign of the covenant (Romans 4:9-12)*
- 3. Salvation was not for the children of Abraham's faith, not his flesh (Romans 4:13-21)*
- 4. All of this was going to be in Jesus, not Abraham (Romans 4:22-25)*

DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

MAIN POINT

The main point of all of this is this: God would be perfectly faithful to the covenant He made with Abraham, but He would do so in ways no one could have predicted. And from that we catch a wonderful glimpse of the creative, faithful, gracious, omnipotent and triune nature of God. And from that we have more and more understanding of what we must do to be saved and fuel for our worship of our Savior.

DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

1. What were your thoughts on the text/sermon? What most stood out? How was it helpful? Confusing?
2. As we read through Genesis, what were your thoughts on Abraham as a husband and father? Why do you think God would allow him to wander so far from His good design for both?
3. What difference does it make in your life that God will never break His promises to you? What difference might it make if you believed that in even greater ways?
4. Which of the six prevailing notions of Abraham's place in NT times stands out to you the most? Is it easy for you to see why the Jews would have believed these things? Have you ever found misbeliefs like these in your own mind?
5. Which of the four NT corrections stands out to you the most? What do you think it would have been like to be a Jew in the NT and hear them for the first time?

AREAS OF APPLICATION

6. How can you become a better husband/wife? How can you become a better parent? Make a list of biblical passages and promises that would direct you to these ends. Find someone to share these with and pray for you.
7. Find a way to express the perfect truthfulness, wisdom, power, and love of God that we see in God's perfect keeping of His covenant promises to Abraham in Jesus.
8. Find one way to strengthen Grace Church by holding up the gospel for us.
9. Pick one area of pride to confess, promise to hope in, and person to pray for and share the gospel with this week.
10. Name one specific thing that you mean to do differently by the power of the Holy Spirit.

PRAYER POINTS

11. Adoration. Praise God for His perfect truthfulness, wisdom, power, and love. Praise Him for salvation in Christ.
12. Confession. Confess ways you've been like Abraham in his marriage and parenting rather than his covenant keeping. Confess any lack of trust in God's promises, misplaced hope, and failure to tell the world about Jesus.
13. Thanksgiving. Thank God for His Word, His Spirit, His Son, and His people. Thank Him for the fact that every minute of every day you are better than you deserve. Thank Him for making every promise "Yes" in Jesus.
14. Supplication. Ask God to save an unbeliever in your life. Ask God to grant increasing trust in His Word and hope in His promises to all of His people--focus on any specific areas of mistrust of failing hope you know in the Christians in your life.
