

SERMON OUTLINE Luke 19:28-44

Worship Him Rightly

Intro

Jesus was clear on His purpose

Expectations of the people

We were made to worship

He weeps

True and full worship is coming soon...Onward.

SERMON DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

MAIN POINT

The Main Point is keeping an eternal perspective, seek to worship Jesus as He is, not how we want Him to be. Through the scriptures and power of the Spirit, you see Him as the Messiah King over your life and Savior of your soul.

DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

1. What were your thoughts on the text/sermon? What most stood out? How was it helpful? Confusing?
2. How have you prepared for Holy Week in the past or this year? Have you thought about the seven days leading up to Resurrection Sunday and what Jesus may have been thinking?
3. In what ways do we think like the people on Palm Sunday? In what ways do we have a different point of view towards Christ?
4. How do you prepare for the more familiar Church holidays like Resurrection Sunday? Do prepare in the same way for the Christmas season? What traditions do you have in place or can introduce in the next year to heighten your experiences?
5. What other prophecies in the Old Testament help you to see Jesus more clearly as God incarnate?
6. How can you take one step closer to Jesus, the Messiah, during this week as an individual, family, and DG?

AREAS OF APPLICATION

7. Take time this week to read through the Gospel of Mark to see the life of Christ leading up to the cross. Reflect on his life during that week and the eternal joy that He had set before Him.
8. Reflect on circumstances that the disciples experienced during this coming week and reflect on circumstances where you have felt God's presence, both a heightened awareness and seeming absence. In what ways can you seek to grow in your awareness of God's presence in your daily life?
9. Discuss with others in your DG or as a family, ways that we celebrate the Resurrection season and how you can carry some of the truths into the following months of 'normal' worship.
10. Read through the closing chapters of Revelation, specifically 21 & 22, to think and pray about how to live considering that will be reality soon. How does thinking about Heaven change the way we live today?

PRAYER POINTS

11. Adoration. Praise God for His eternal plan of salvation through Christ. Praise Jesus for His obedience to "face Jerusalem" where He would meet death willingly.
12. Confess. Confess ways that you have held onto sin instead of repented of it. Confess where you have looked to Jesus as a "genie in a bottle" and not the King of Creation.
13. Thanksgiving. Thank the LORD for a new heart and mind in Christ. Thank Him for opening your eyes to see and worship Him rightly and with joy. Thank Jesus for His deep love and mercy towards you when you fall short.
14. Supplication. Ask God to stir in your heart a renewed sense of awe and worship. As the LORD to worship Him this week in a fresh way with renewed joy in the salvation He accomplished on the cross.
