SERMON OUTLINE Various Texts

Mothers Are Life-Givers | David VanAcker

MOTHERS ARE PHYSICAL LIFE-GIVERS

- 2. Physical life-giving is made harder by the fall (Genesis 3:16).
- 3. Motherhood is a gift from God (Genesis 16:1, 21:2; Matthew 1:20).
- 4. Motherhood is a noble aspiration.
- 5. Motherhood is praise-worthy (Proverbs 31:28, 23:22, 25; 1 Kings 2:29).
- 6. Mothers are physical life-sustainers (Proverbs 31).

MOTHERS ARE SPIRITUAL LIFE-GIVERS

- 1. To be a mother in the fullest sense is to be a spiritual life-giver (2 Timothy 1:5).
- 2. To be a mother in the fullest sense is to be a spiritual life- sustainer (Titus 2:3-5; 2 Timothy 3:14-15).
- 3. All who seek the spiritual life and growth of others are engaged in a kind of spiritual motherhood (1 Thess 2:7-8).



MAIN POINT

There are two main points to this sermon and one main take-away. First, by God's design, mothers are physical life-givers. And second, also by God's design, mothers are spiritual life-givers. My primary hope in giving this sermon is to communicate these truths and therein encourage the moms of Grace Church to recommit to finding joy in seeking these kinds of fruit in motherhood.

DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

- 1. What were your thoughts on the text/sermon? What most stood out? How was it helpful? Confusing?
- 2. Had you ever thought of motherhood as physical and spiritual life-giving and life-sustaining? How have you seen these things done well? How have you seen them done poorly?
- 3. What are some ways that your life-giving (physical or spiritual) has been made more difficult by the fall?
- 4. Is it easy for you to view motherhood as a gift from God? Is it easy for you to see it as a noble aspiration? Is it easy for you to praise the mothers in your life who embrace God's call on their mothering?
- 5. How is your spiritual mothering going? Where are you seeing life, growth and maturity?
- 6. What do you think of the idea that all who engage in spiritual life-giving and sustaining are a kind of spiritual mother?

AREAS OF APPLICATION

- 7. Praise the godly mothers in your life. Find a specific way to express your appreciation for God's work in and through them. As best as you are able, root your praise to a particular Biblical charge or description.
- 8. Find a specific way to make someone's mothering easier this week. If you are a kid, ask your mom how you can help. If you are being discipled by someone, go out of your way to make their discipleship of you easier.
- 9. Share the gospel with someone this week.
- 10. Go out of your way to encourage someone in their faith in a specific way this week.
- 11. What is one specific thing you mean to do differently in the power of the Spirit as a result of the things you saw or heard in this text or sermon?

PRAYER POINTS

- 12. Adoration. Praise God as the one true life-giver and sustainer. Praise God for His wisdom and power that are on display in the life-giving and sustaining work of moms. Praise God for including us in HIs great plan of redemption.
- 13. Confession. Confess any sin of minimizing the great call of motherhood or maximizing some lesser call. Confess any sin of making the lives of the mothers in your life harder. Ask God to forgive you for failing to fully and joyfully engage in motherhood.
- 14. Thanksgiving. Thank God that He always equips you for everything to which He calls you. Thank God for the remarkable picture of His nature that motherhood paints. Thank God for your mom.
- 15. Supplication. Pray for the moms in your life, asking God to give them joy in their mothering, strength for their mothering, and fruit from their mothering. Pray for the non-Christians in your life, that they might receive the new birth.
