SERMON DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

MAIN POINT

In this sermon, I intend to give a quick overview of the Gospel and then highlight a few of the main themes that God especially used to challenge and strengthen us from it. My hope in doing this is to encourage you all by taking one more look at the unique glories in John and to strengthen you all to believe and live more and more fully in light of those glories.

DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

1. What were your thoughts on the text/sermon? What most stood out? How was it helpful? Confusing?
2. What stood out to you the most from our time in the Gospel of John? What was most challenging, convicting, confusing, encouraging? Are there any specific ways that God has worked in your life as a result of John?
3. In what ways have you most been able to see the glory of God in John?
4. Can you restate the main point of John in your own words? What text(s) come to mind?
5. Do you believe that Jesus is the Christ? If so, why? If not, why not?
6. Which of Jesus' signs or claims seem most spectacular to you? Why?
7. Of the four "graces for Grace" that Pastor Dave mentioned (above), which has been most important for you?
8. In what way/s did the sermon help you see the greatness of God?

AREAS OF APPLICATION

9. Download and use the Fighter Verse app on your phone to memorize Scripture.
10. Commit to a Bible reading plan that will help you read the entire Bible and ask someone to join you.
11. Pray for and share the good news of Jesus with one non-Christian this week that they might not die in their sin..
12. Begin reading through Ecclesiastes in preparation for Pastor Dave's next sermons.
13. Decide on one way to live more faithfully in 2025 than you did last year. Share that with someone.
14. Ask two different people in your family or DG (1) One thing they got from this sermon, and (2) How you can pray for them.
15. What is one specific thing you mean to do differently as a result of the things you saw or heard in this text or sermon?

PRAYER POINTS

16. Adoration. Praise God that He is sovereign, wise and good. Praise God that He is creator, sustainer, governor, and savior of the world. Praise God that He is the way, the truth, and the life. Praise God that Jesus is the bread of life, the light of the world, the good shepherd, the Son of God, the resurrection, and the true vine.
17. Confess. Confess any unbelieving belief in your life. Confess any ways in which you are indifferent to the glory of God in Jesus. Confess any ways you are following something other than Jesus and any ways you are not following Jesus.
18. Thanksgiving. Thank God for John's Gospel and the opportunity He gave us to spend so much time in it over the past couple of years. Thank God for offering eternal life in Jesus. Thank God for revealing His glory to us in Jesus.
19. Supplication. Ask God to make us even more of a Bible-loving and living church. Ask God to help us follow Jesus in all we do. Ask God to give us the desires of our hearts. Ask God to give us eyes to see His glory everywhere He's revealed it. Ask God to prepare us well for Ecclesiastes. Ask God to burden us to share our faith in and love for Jesus with the world.
